



KURL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

TOOLS NEEDED

- Fasteners appropriate for your installation surface (not included)
- Tools will vary, based on foundation structure and fasteners used

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Choose an installaiton location that is structurally sound, and locate wall studs (if applicable). Select fasteners suitable for the wall you are installing on.
2. Space each KURL rack according to the length of your kayak as well as what your wall will structurally accomodate, and mark the holes with a level and/or square. Consider the height at which you want to store your kayak at this time as well.
3. If the fasteners you are using are larger than the factory holes in the KURL, you will need to expand the factory holes with the appropriate drill bit.
4. If pilot holes are necessary for your fasteners, drill those at this time (even if pilot holes aren't required, we reccomend them to keep the KURL steady while mounting).
5. Fasten the KURL to a sturdy foundation, using the appropriate fasteners and tools for the surface: i.e. lag bolts, carriage bolts, concrete bolts, etc.
